#### **Life Application**

Pray & Ask God for a Bible verse that would be meaningful to our life right now.

- Sometimes we get it right Book, chapter, verse
- Sometimes we miss it. So, we ask again.

**Sample Prayer**: Thank you for hearing us & knowing our hearts. We are hungry for more of You God. We long to learn how to hear You more clearly and understand Your heart toward us. We cover ourselves in the blood of Jesus that washes us clean. We lift the shield of Faith now to extinguish any fiery darts of the enemy. We put on the helmet of salvation that reminds us of who we are in Christ Jesus. We put on the mind of Christ. Open our hears to hear Your voice today. Father, please give me a Bible reference to let me know Your thoughts towards me today.

**Scripture** – Ask God that He would give you a Bible verse for the other person. Then ask Him for one specific aspect/word/part of this verse that He highlights for the one you are ministering to. Then ask Him what He wants to tell the other person through it.

One of the pitfalls is that people start to preach the Word. We
don't want to explain the other person what the Bible verse means
but what God wants to say through this verse to the other person.
It's a prophetic exercise in which we want to hear the personal
message that is on God's heart right now specifically for the one
we are ministering to.

## **Life Application**

## **Ministering**

How to's for ministering the prophetic word

Common ways God speaks during prophetic ministry
<ul> <li>Word of God, (inner knowing),</li> <li>inner images, pictures or visions (animated images),</li> <li>hearing (mostly internal) and</li> <li>feeling (emotional and physical)</li> </ul>
<b>Tips</b> to improve the quality of prophetic words and ministry times & to keep us safe from the pitfalls
1. Ask God for an interpretation
<ul> <li>If you get the interpretation, skip the revelation</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Don't interpret when you don't get an interpretation</li> </ul>
2. Trust the still, small voice
3. Go with the first thing you receive
4. Don't forget to listen for yourself
5. God always speaks
6. You hear more easily and clearly in His presence

7. We hear Him more when we expect Him to speak

- 8. Prophesy is mostly love and a little bit instruction
- 9. Prophesy out of God's emotions
- 10. Prophesy with Scripture
- 11. Prophesy to the measure of your faith
  - No mates, dates, babies and offices
    - very intimate topics
      - where a lot of harm can be done and a lot of pain is inflicted if they turn out to not be true.
- 12. Avoid expressions like "God says"
  - Questions to ponder
    - Are you really that certain that this word is fully and genuinely from God?
    - And if it later becomes apparent that it wasn't, will you take full responsibility to set things right and to unmake all damage caused by it?
- 13. Create a warm, safe and honoring atmosphere
- 14. Watch your gestures and facial expressions
- 15. Refrain from physical contact unless you specifically asked for permission
- 16. Prophesy the positive

17. Don't judge your prophecy by the existence or absence of a sense of anointing 18. Don't compare yourself 19. Take it easy, especially on tough days 20. God often uses what He is speaking to you personally at the moment 21.God has humor 22. Forget what you think you know about a person or what seems to be apparent 23. Prophetic team ministry and building on each other's words 24. Keep your words short 25. Prophetic intercession 26. Prophetic prayer 27. Don't stop practicing
